STATEMENT FROM MPAA CHAIRMAN AND CEO SENATOR CHRIS DODD ON BRAZILIAN PLANE CRASH

WASHINGTON – The following is a statement from Senator Chris Dodd, Chairman and CEO of the Motion Picture Association of America, Inc., on the tragic plane crash involving Brazil's Chapecoense soccer team that occurred overnight near Medellín, Columbia.
